Vision

Core Principles

Key Policy Areas

7. Community Engagement

- Involve parents, local organizations, and the wider community in green initiatives.
- Celebrate achievements through events, awards, and public recognition.

8. Monitoring and Continuous Improvement

- Conduct regular sustainability audits (energy, water, waste).
- Set measurable goals and review progress annually, adjusting strategies as needed.

- Establish a Green School Committee with representatives from students, staff, and parents to oversee policy execution.
- Provide ongoing training and resources for staff and students.
- Encourage feedback and new ideas from the school community.
