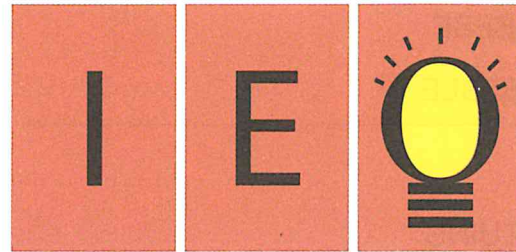

Italy has a long history. After the Roman Empire broke down, there were many separate kingdoms and city states. Italy became one nation in 1861 and since then the country also includes the islands of Sicily and Sardegna. The 'Kingdom of Italy' lasted from 1861 until 1946. The Italian Republic was formed in 1946. Italy lies in Southern Europe and is one of the six founding countries of the European Union (EU). Italy borders six countries: France, Austria, Switzerland, Slovenia, Vatican City and San Marino.

Italy is easy to recognise on any world map, as the country is shaped like a high-heeled boot and it looks like it is kicking a ball, which is the island of Sicily. The country is slightly larger in size than the UK, the Netherlands and Belgium combined. This makes it the tenth largest country, just behind Poland, in terms of size and it is nearly 100 times bigger than the smallest European country.

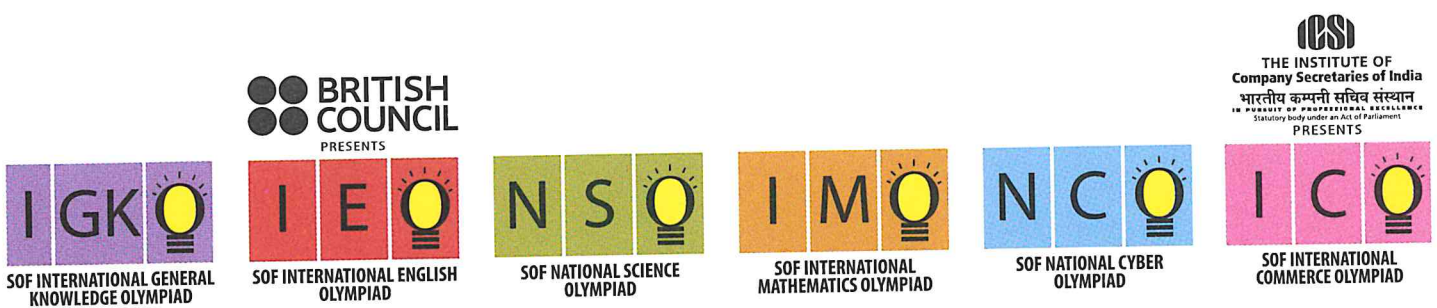
